#### How many classes will each student take?

All S-DMS students (grades 6th - 8th) will take seven academic classes.

#### What is MTSS?

All students will have MTSS. During this time students will participate in remediation or enrichment activities.

#### How do I know what content is covered in each elective course?

#### What is the difference between a semester, full year, and 9 weeks course?

Full year courses: are classes which meet every day all year (180 days)

Semester courses: are classes which meet every day for half of the year (90 days). Semester classes run either from August through December or January through May.

9 week courses (PE & Exploring College/Careers ONLY): are classes which meet every day for 9 weeks (45 days). These courses may meet 1st, 2nd, 3rd, or 4th quarter.

#### Do I have to take Exploring College & Careers and/or Reading?

Yes. S-DMS is committed to providing the best academic preparation for your student's high school career. Exploring college & careers, and literacy skills are both areas which are critical. Regardless of current proficiency level, all students can improve upon literacy skills.

#### When will I receive my schedule?

#### Will I get all of my elective choices?
